

s you know our covenants require that all A boats be stored either in a closed garage or in the back yards of residents' properties, on a trailer, and covered with a tarp. However, during our official "boating season" (May 1st -September 30th), the Association accepts the presumption that boats are continuously "in transition" from storage to use. Under this presumption, no resident will be cited with a violation, for boats parked on the "sides" of houses, provided they are located at least 3 feet from the nearest property line & not forward of the front foundation of the house. Please remember that per our covenants AND Town Ordinance. boats may never be parked in front of houses. including in driveways or on the street.
